Question 1: Basic concept of sociology in social pharmacy

- (a) We commonly think about health as the absence of signs that the body is not functioning properly or absence of symptoms of disease or injury. Define health according to the World Health Organization and Talcott Parsons. (4 marks)
- (b) Explain how Talcott Parsons' definition of health compliments that of the WHO.

- (d) Using hypertension as an example, explain this statement: A person may have a disease and not be ill, might be ill but not have a disease or might have both an illness and a disease.

Question 2: Basic concept of psychology

- a) Give a brief explanation of the behavioral decision theory. (4 marks)
- b) In behavioural decision theory, Hogarth described different biases that people tend to have in decision-making, which may be helpful in understanding patient choices about health behavior. Mention any **three** (3) biases in decision-making and use examples to explain these biases. (6 marks)
- c) The **theory of reasoned action** proposes that the subjective norm and the attitude regarding the behavior combine to produce an intension, which leads to the behavior. Define attitude and subjective norm in this context. Use physical exercise as an example to show how subjective norm and the attitude lead to behavior. (10 marks)

Question 3: Treatment process and healthcare team
