Discuss in clear details, the pathogenesis (5) of the following disorders, indicating the pathophysiology of the two distinguishing signs and symptoms (4) and long term complication (1) given

- 1. Severe Acute asthma
- 2. Secondary osteoarthritis
- 3. GERD

Outline in clear details, the stepwise (2 per step) drug treatment of the following disorders in terms of drug regimens (1) and formulations (1) 10 marks each

- 1. Chronic asthma in adolescents aged 12+ years according to GINA 2019
- 2. Rheumatoid arthritis in patients at risk of pulmonary TB
- 3. Peptic ulcer disease confirmed with + *H.pylori* later

QUESTION THREE 15 MARKS

Outline mechanisms of action of the following drugs in the treatment of the disorders given

3 marks each

- 1. Budesonide in chronic asthma
- 2. Amoxicillin in infective COPD
- 3. Glucosamine in osteoarthritis
- 4. Omeprazole in duodenal ulcers
- 5. Lactulose in constipation

QUESTION FOUR 15 MARKS

Justify the rationale behind combination of the following drugs in the treatment of the disorders given

3 marks each

- 1. Ipratropium/salbutamol in COPD
- 2. Probenecid and sodium bicarbonate in gouty arthritis
- 3. Diphenoxylate/atropine in diarrhea
- 4. Aluminium hydroxide and alginic acid in GERD
- 5. Zinc oxide and bismuth oxide in haemorrhoids

QUESTION FIVE 10 MARKS

Discuss and rationalize therapeutic approaches (include drug regimens) you would recommend for patients prescribed the following treatments? **2 marks each**

- 1. A newly encountered patient complaining of severe chest pain
- 2. A patient experiencing diarrhea following intake of broad spectrum antibiotics
- Patient taking budesonide 400mcg/formoterol 12mcg inhaler once daily experiencing more than 2 attacks per week
- 4. A known gouty arthritic patient experiencing more arthritic pain following allopurinol initiation
- 5. A known hypertensive patient on HCTZ and ASA newly diagnosed with gout
