In March 2023, Thabo notified Neo that he had finished doing the repairs on the car. When Neo came to collect the car, he was told that the bill for the repairs was M50 000. Unfortunately, Neo could only raise M15 000. Hhe however, he requested to take the car on a test drive. When Neo came back, he informed Thabo that the car had developed yet another problem and that he had to leave it at his house. Thabo is desirous of collecting the vehicle alleging that he has a lien over it. The agreement for repairs was done unknown to Thabo that the car had already been sold to Pule. Thabo has approached you for legal advice in the belief that he has a preferred right over the motor vehicle.

With the aid of relevant case law, advice Thabo on his prospects of success on the apparent legal saga between him and Pule.

Tapole, on the other hand, feels that since Pitso has been using the apartment for some other purpose other than for the purpose for which it was rented, he is not entitled to any compensation or remission of rent.
