Critically discuss using legal feminist theories on whether government should legislatively enforce women's representation in positions of power and decision making.

To change that would go against natural law and to legalize same sex marriages is a denial of marriage's role of procreation. In fury, the LGBQTI+ community issued a commentary on national television arguing that "equal rights must mean equal rights. If you do not legalize same-sex marriages, we will fight all the way to the international courts."

You are legal theorist, using case law and other relevant jurisprudence, write an opinion letter to the government of country X advising government on whether they should or should not legislatively safeguard the human rights of LGBQTI+ people.
