- 2. With reference to the Nile River and the Zambezi River, react to the assertion that regional and bilateral arrangements on the management of transboundary water bodies have led more to conflict than cooperation.
- 3. Critically examine the effectiveness of regional protocols and agreements on the management of forestry and biodiversity resources in **either** West Africa **or** East Africa in the last twenty years.
- 4. Using either the Maloti-Drakensberg Trans-frontier Conservation and Development Project or the Great Limpopo Trans-frontier Conservation Park, discuss the main successes and pitfalls of attempts at a collaborative approach to natural resource conservation.
- 5. Write an appraisal of regional efforts by Southern African nations to control the spread of the COVID-19 pandemic between 2020 and 2022.
- 6. Using either the East African Community or SADC, discuss the view that a collaborative approach to reducing the effects of climate change on the economies of the region has been undermined by narrow national interests.
